"ICE will not carry out enforcement operations at or near health care facilities, such as hospitals, doctors' offices, accredited health clinics, and emergent or urgent care facilities, except in the most extraordinary of circumstances. Individuals should not avoid seeking medical care because they fear civil immigration enforcement."

### **COVID-19 AND IMMIGRATION LAW**

**USCIS COVID-19 Public Charge Notice**

Language(s): English and Spanish

USCIS does not consider vaccinations when making public charge inadmissibility determinations. USCIS encourages everyone, including noncitizens, to seek necessary medical care, including treatment or preventive services for COVID-19. You may seek pandemic-related

benefits and services (including food assistance, housing programs, and others) for which you are eligible—without fear of negative consequences to your immigration status.
