The following information must be submitted to the Cornell Law School by December 1:

- 1) PILIPP Application Form
- 2) Loan Documentation
All loans must be in good standing and in repayment. You must provide the following:
 - Your most recent bill showing your payment date, amount and repayment plan
 - If you are enrolled in IBR or PAYE: A general account summary that identifies all loans included in your IBR or PAYE payment
- 3) Copy of your 2021 Federal Tax Return. *Note: You will need to submit a copy of your 2022 Federal Tax Return as soon as it is available.*
- 4) Employer Certification
This form must be submitted directly to the Law School's Financial Aid Office at PILIPP@cornell.edu by your employer.
